#### January 15, 2018

Appanoose County Board of Supervisors met in regular session January 15, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Courthouse. Present: Mark Waits, Chairman (via telephone), Neal Smith and Linda Demry, Boardmembers. Absent: None.

Meeting started with the Pledge.

Waits motioned to approve the agenda. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Demry motioned to approve the minutes of the January 2, 2018 meeting. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

There were no public comments.

Dr. Heikes, JeNel Barth, and Nicole Cox from the Drake Library Board spoke to the board about the costs, services, importance of the Library, and requested a \$20,000 contribution. Last several years \$8,900 has been contributed. Demry stated they will take this into account when doing the budget.

Misty Rosenberg from ADLM Environmental Health turned over a delinquent Iconium Sewer bill for \$168.00. Demry mentioned they do not have to go through a board meeting and can be given to the auditor directly.

Peggy Johnson from Rathbun YMCA gave the board a brochure, spoke about their programs, and requested a continued \$7,000 contribution. Demry motioned to commit \$7,000 to the Rathbun YMCA. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Demry spoke about the Appanoose County Coalition for the Arts Grant project. The form does not commit to anything. Demry motioned to submit the county's interest in the project (exterior doors and basement repairs). Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Demry motioned to approve the liquor license for the Appanoose County Country Club (pending Dram). Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Demry motioned to open the public hearing for ZOMA 1217-01. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Eric Cremeens spoke to the board about needing the zoning change from Ag to Commercial in order to sell vehicles. Demry asked what the Zoning Commissions recommendation was. Jon Foster, Zoning Administrator, stated they approved the change. Ordinance number ZOMA 1227-01 was read. There were no further public comments. Demry motioned to close the public hearing. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Demry motioned to approve Ordinance Number ZOMA 1227-01 changing from agricultural to commercial. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Demry motioned to waive the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings of Ordinance Number ZOMA 1227-01. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Waits left the meeting (via telephone) at 9:32 A.M.

Demry motioned to open the public hearing for tax sales #5352, #5353, #5354, #5360, #4613, #4614, #4615, #4616, and #4617. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. There were opening bids of \$10 on each of the tax sales by Michael Young. No other bids were received. Demry motioned to close the public hearing. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Smith motioned to approve the \$10 bids on tax sale #5352, #5353, #5354, #5360, #4613, #4614, #4615, #4616, and #4617. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

County Engineer, Matt Haden, presented the board the ADA Transition Plan for approval. Demry motioned to table it until the February 5<sup>th</sup> meeting to give them a chance to examine it. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Haden presented a resolution vacating a right-of-way described as: A part of the NW ¼ of Section 7, Township 69 North, Range 18 West of the Principal Meridian, Appanoose County, Iowa, more particular described as follows, Commencing at the NW Corner of 7-69-18, and proceeding thence North 89°25′21″ East a distance of 741.12 feet; thence South 00°34′26″ East a distance of 84.88 feet to the Point of Beginning, said point lying on the Southerly right-of-way line of Appanoose County Road 470<sup>th</sup> Street; thence North 89°23′04″ East a distance of 100.76 feet; thence South 42°32′21″ East a distance of 612.66 feet; thence South 00°39′19″ East a distance of 112.29 feet; thence North 42°32′21″ East a distance of 763.59 feet; to the Point of Beginning, said tract containing 1.184 acres, more or less. Demry motioned to approve the resolution vacating a portion of county right-of-way on 470<sup>th</sup> Street. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Haden showed the board a bridge replacement map. His plan is to do 5 bridges a year for 5 years. Demry requested a copy of the map for their office. Haden will have one produced. The crews have been working on snow removal and brush cutting.

CDS Coordinator, Stephanie Koch has been working with homeless to find housing. She will be closed next week, Wednesday-Friday for her C3 training. The Governing Board will meet in Ottumwa tomorrow. RHD, the Housing 1st Program, provided training on how to maintain housing.

Demry motioned to approve payroll, prisoner room and board transfer, Sheriff, Auditor & Recorder Quarterly Reports, and Tax Suspension list. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.
