Appanoose County Board of Supervisors met in regular session January 4, 2021 at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Courthouse. Present: Linda Demry, Chairperson, Mark McGill and Jeff Kulmatycki, Boardmembers. Absent: none.

Meeting started with the Pledge.

Resolution #2021-02 Interfund Loan to be added to agenda. Kulmatycki motioned to approve the amended agenda. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to approve the minutes from the December 21, 2020 meeting. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to appoint Linda Demry, Chairperson. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye. Kulmatycki motioned to appoint Mark McGill Vice-Chair. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to set the regular board meetings the first and third Mondays of each month starting at 9 A.M. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to designate the Moravia Union as the legal publication for Appanoose County. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve President's Day (2/15), Memorial Day (5/31), Independence Day (7/5), Labor Day (9/6), Veteran's Day (11/11), Thanksgiving (11/25 & 11/26), Christmas (12/24 and 12/27), and New Year's (12/31/2022) as county paid holidays. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Compensation Board member Ray Tresemer spoke on the boards behalf. McGill motioned to cut the recommendations by 75%. Seconded by Demry. Demry and McGill voted aye. Kulmatycki voted nay.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve Resolution # 2021-01. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

RESOLUTION #2021-01

CONSTRUCTION EVALUATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a board of supervisors wishes to adopt a "construction evaluation resolution" relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR's decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the board of supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received

by the board of supervisors between February 1, 2021 and January 31, 2022 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and
WHEREAS, the board of supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board's recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF APPANOOSE COUNTY that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

Kulmatycki motioned to accept the Preliminary Plat for Timber and Tines Subdivision. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to accept the resignation letter from Trista Barbaglia as the Veteran Affairs Administrator effective 12/10/2020. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

John Hansen (via phone) provided an update on the law center project. They are set for a March bidding. Hansen was able to negotiate a reduction in the fees Hall Engineering will charge for the topographic survey and civil engineering. It reduced from \$26,670 to \$23,600. Kulmatycki motioned to award the remaining civil engineering services to Hall Engineering. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Steve Hoffman from Servpro (via phone) explained his estimate of work on the DHS Building. Kulmatycki motioned to approve the Servpro estimate. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

There was no action taken extending COVID-19 Families First paid leave.

McGill motioned to table the approval of SUDAS Chapter 5I. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

County Engineer, Brad Skinner presented the 5 year plan. The plan was discussed. No action taken. The department has been busy with snow and ice removal. Per their ordinance, the department will remove snow/ice between 4 A.M. and 5 P.M. There was a fatal accident over New Years. An investigation is underway. McGill asked about ice blades on maintainers. Two machines have them on currently. Dan Furlin Jr. asked that something be done about the snow/ice removal on the roads. Highway J46 was completely covered in Appanoose County and clear in Wayne County. He requested more money spent on salt. Skinner stated they use a 3 to 1 sand to salt mixture but it changes for different events. There was discussion regarding the difference between Monroe and Wayne Counties. Demry requested Skinner check into it.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve Resolution # 2021-02. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

RESOLUTION #2021-02

INTERFUND LOAN

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the Auditor to transfer a sum from the General Basic Fund to the Capital Projects Fund during the 2020-2021 budget year, and

WHEREAS, said interfund loan transfer must be in accordance with Section 331.477(2), Code of Iowa, NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, Iowa, as follows:

The interfund loan transfer from the General Basic Fund to the Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$450,000, with anticipated repayment will be no later than the end of 2020-2021 fiscal year.

The Auditor is directed to correct her books when said loan transfers are made and to notify the Treasurer of the amount of the said transfer.

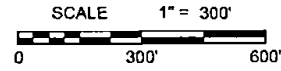
