2022 County Five Year Program Resolution 0.2

Appanoose County Secondary Roads

Whereas, unforeseen circumstances have arisen since adoption of the approved Secondary Road Five Year Program, requiring changes to the sequence, funding, and timing of the proposed work plan.

Now therefore be it resolved, the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, Iowa, in accordance with Iowa Code section 309.22, initiates and recommends addition of the following project in the accomplishment year (State Fiscal Year 2022), for approval by the Iowa Department of Transportation (Iowa DOT), per Iowa Code 309.23 and Iowa DOT Instructional Memorandum 2.050. The following projects shall be REMOVED from the Program's Accomplishment year:

- a. Project No. FM-C004()-55-04, Exline Overlay. 950 AADT, 1.50 miles, 366 HMA Paving, Farm-to-Market Funding of \$200,000

The following projects shall be MODIFIED to incorporate the above, as follows:

- b. Project No. FM-C004(116)-55-04, On T-30, from IA-5 east and south 6.14 miles to Missouri State Line. 900 AADT, 366 HMA Paving, Farm-to-Market Funding of \$1,400,000





The flatcars were set two weeks ago. 550th Street will be completed first then they will move to 265th. Plans were resubmitted to the DOT for the T30 project. The office continues to work on plans for next year. They will work on road vacations this winter. Demry asked about the winter equipment. There are still some equipment that needs repaired. Kulmatycki asked about the lighting on Industrial Road. Skinner stated the arms were just received and they should be up shortly. McGill stated he has received several complaints regarding J3T. Skinner said they can cold patch on top of the seal coat. Striping should be completed soon.

John Hansen provided an update to the board. Steel is on site, precast will be poured the 19th. 26th for the Administration office. Concrete has been completed in the metal building. McGill motioned to approve proceeding with a 100,000 btu furnace for the steel building from Proctor Mechanical. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye. The November project cost recap was presented. McGill motioned to approve the bills in the amount of \$421,129.02. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.


