Mike Schill from Natel presented their plans for broadband expansion in Appanoose County. They were awarded \$257,000 in grant funds from the state for their \$1,800,000 estimated project cost and is seeking county ARP funds. No action was taken.

Beth Burgin, Zoning Administrator, requested the reappointment of Jerry Howe, Jeremy Long, Danielle Joiner, David Gee, and Randy Walker to the Zoning Board for a 3-year term expiring 1/1/2025. McGill motioned to approve the appointments of Jerry Howe, Jeremy Long, Danielle Joiner, David Gee and Randy Walker. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

He will be giving a revised schedule to the contractors with a completion date in August. Change Order 1-1 to SG Construction for \$8,196.10 was presented. Kulmatycki motioned to approve Change Order 1-1 for \$8,196.10. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye. Change Order 3-2 to Tony's Plumbing for \$17,575 was presented. Kulmatycki motioned to

Demry stated the next regular board meeting will be Tuesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> due to President's Day on Monday, February 21<sup>st</sup>.


