Robert Ritter asked for the documents he requested last week from the Auditor and witness the vote to approve the budget. Demry stated the budget was not being voted on today. No documents were presented to Ritter.

Mike Schill from Natel presented their plans for broadband expansion in Appanoose County. They were awarded \$257,000 in grant funds from the state for their \$1,800,000 estimated project cost and is seeking county ARP funds. No action was taken.

Beth Burgin, Zoning Administrator, requested the reappointment of Jerry Howe, Jeremy Long, Danielle Joiner, David Gee, and Randy Walker to the Zoning Board for a 3-year term expiring 1/1/2025. McGill motioned to approve the appointments of Jerry Howe, Jeremy Long, Danielle Joiner, David Gee and Randy Walker. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

Mike Barth, Assessor, requested the board to approve the GIS Data Grant Agreement with FYRA Engineering. Kulmatycki motioned to approve the GIS Data Grant Agreement with FYRA. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to accept the Preliminary Plat for Sunset Ridge. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki spoke about the benefits of the ISAC Wellness Program. Kulmatycki motioned to approve the 2022 ISAC Wellness Program Agreement. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to approve the EMS Income Surtax distribution. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to approve the Bond to Insure Against Double Payment to U.S. Cellular check #43972 \$75.08, #43971 \$59.34, and #43970 \$60; and Diane Thomas check #37986 \$239.90. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

Sheriff Gary Anderson presented a resignation letter from Alexis Valentine. Kulmatycki motioned to accept the resignation of Alexis Valentine as Jailer effective 2/9/2022. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye. There was no action taken on ARP funding. A list of hours spent in the 10 surrounding communities was presented. Demry requested Anderson develop a contract for the communities for contract law and present it to the board.

John Hansen provided an update to the board on the jail project. Heat will be in the metal building this week and the pod will be removed this month. He will be giving a revised schedule to the contractors with a completion date in August. Change Order 1-1 to SG Construction for \$8,196.10 was presented. Kulmatycki motioned to approve Change Order 1-1 for \$8,196.10. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye. Change Order 3-2 to Tony's Plumbing for \$17,575 was presented. Kulmatycki motioned to

approve Change Order 3-2 for \$17,575. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye. Change Order 4-1 to Proctor Mechanical for \$13,325 was presented. Kulmatycki motioned to approve Change Oder 4-1 for \$13,325. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye. Hansen presented a pay application dated 2/1/2022. McGill motioned to approve the 2/1/2022 pay application in the amount of \$457,365.54. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

County Engineer, Brad Skinner, provided an update to the board. The department was awarded with the best county paving project for the T20 project south of Cincinnati. The crews will work on brush cutting and bridge repair if not doing snow removal. Skinner spoke about the federal transportation bill.

Public Comments: County Attorney Susan Cole spoke with Mr. Ritter regarding the documents he was looking for and she is unable to provide them. Mr. Ritter spoke about reusing road materials, the bridge on 560th in Franklin Township, information regarding Tom McKay’s death and IPERS benefits. Tammy Wheeler from Farmers Mutual Communications provided an update on their fiber project. Demry stated the next regular board meeting will be Tuesday, February 22nd due to President’s Day on Monday, February 21st.

McGill motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.






