McGill motioned to approve the handwritten check for A-1 Mobile Storage for \$285. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve the liquor licenses for K and T Partnership and Appanoose Country Club. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Robert Ritter asked if the bridge on 560th was looked at; a copy of the lawsuit that doesn't allow road materials in the middle of the road be supplied, that a 2-pass road system could be voted on; a copy of the law that grants the board amnesty from prosecution; copies of the evidence in Tom McKay's death; a copy of a voluntary statement given to the elected officials; forms the Governor stated were available; and that the approval of the roads budget be suspended and the department not be re-hired. Skinner will look into the bridge. Demry stated the 2-pass road system is not something they would vote on, the roads department would handle that. County Attorney, Susan Cole, addressed the lawsuits and voluntary statement. The Auditor addressed the forms on the budget. Sheriff, Gary Anderson, addressed the evidence in Tom McKay's death.

McGill motioned to set the public hearing for the FY2023 Max Tax Levy for 3/7/2022 at 9:15 A.M. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to appoint Bruce Ellison to the Conservation Board. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve signing a letter of support for Iowa Great Places. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve the Bond to Insure Against Double Payment to Shaun Cassady check #29066 for \$20. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve voiding outstanding auditor warrants #38717 \$195.06, #39199 \$600, and #1009 \$10 and treasurer warrants #8640 \$6 and #8702 \$34. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve the tax abatement for David Ferguson. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

Kulmatycki motioned to approve the FY23 PPME, Local 2003 union contract. Seconded by McGill. All voted aye.

McGill motioned to set the public hearing to change 216th St from a level "C" to a level "A" road for 3/7/2022 at 9:20 A.M. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

County Engineer, Brad Skinner, provided an update to the board. The Exline overlay project letting was last week. Costs came in higher than anticipated. They have been dealing with parts supply issues for down equipment. There was discussion regarding the rural services tax levy transfer to the roads department budget. Demry asked about the Boyer Ridge Road Bridge. Skinner stated he proposed to the railroad on doing a 50/50 cost split on the temporary repairs but hasn't heard back. Kulmatycki asked if the graders were currently running. Skinner stated they are only doing spot work so they don't tear up the roads. Kulmatycki also asked about spraying. Skinner stated they are spraying the stumps.

Public Comments: none.

McGill motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Kulmatycki. All voted aye.

The Board adjourned to meet at the call of the Auditor at 9:37 A.M.
