**RESOLUTION #2022-07 FOR INTERFUND OPERATING TRANSFER**

Whereas, it is desired to transfer monies from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund, and Whereas, said operating transfer is in accordance with section 331.432, Code of Iowa, Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, Iowa as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$202,086.50 is ordered to be transferred from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund, effective 3-21-2022.

McGill motioned to set the public hearing for Sunset Ridge Subdivision Final Plat for April 4, 2022 at 9:20 A.M. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Demry tabled the Right of Entry Agreement with Canadian Pacific for the Boyer Ridge Road Bridge repairs until the county attorney can review the agreement.

Skinner discussed IJA funding and changes to the 5 year plan down the road.

Skinner provided an update to the board. 10 hour days will wait until April 11<sup>th</sup>. There were a couple calls regarding muddy spots following last weeks rain. They received quotes on contract rock. Cantera had the best price on all but 1 of the 36 locations. The cost is \$363,000. Demry asked about Wind-n-Waves. Skinner stated there are no markers when doing snow removal but they have tried to fix the sod.

CDC Coordinator Stephanie Koch provided an update to the board. The next Governing Board meeting will be March 23<sup>rd</sup> at 2 P.M. in Ottumwa (zoom or in person). Adult Advisory will be April 7<sup>th</sup> at 1 P.M. followed by Child Advisory at 2 P.M. She will be continuing C3 Training in April. She conducted some outreach to Centerville Schools of emergency service available.

Public Comments: Tammy Wheeler from Farmer's Mutual provided an update on their fiber project. She requested to be on the broadband committee if one is formed.

McGill motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.
