ORDINANCE NO.55

AN ORDINANCE to eliminate the residency requirement for Appanoose County Sheriff's Deputies and employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF APPANOOSE COUNTY, IOWA

SECTION 1 – **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to eliminate the state residency requirement for Appanoose County Sheriff's Deputies as required by the lowa Law Enforcement Academy, Iowa Administrative Code 501 - 2.1(1).

SECTION 2 – RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT ELIMINATED. As of the effective date of this ordinance, Appanoose County Sheriff's Deputies and employees will no longer be required to be residents of the State of Iowa.

SECTION 3 – TIME AND DISTANCE REQUIREMENT. The Sheriff's Office shall access the needs and demands of their office and shall establish a time and distance policy for the employees and their office.

SECTION 4 – EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
