WHEREAS, Appanoose County contracts for EMS for its residents.

WHEREAS, ensuring efficient and effective EMS coverage is essential for maintaining the health and welfare of its residents.

WHEREAS, to be able to efficiently and effectively provide EMS to its residents, the Board of Supervisors will proceed with the process under Iowa Code Section 422D.1 to declare emergency medical services as an essential county service to allow a local option income surtax and/or an ad valorem property tax for EMS and the creation of a county emergency medical services system advisory council to assist in researching and assessing the service needs of the county and guiding the implementation of the same.

WHEREAS, Appanoose County on May 15, 2023, directed that notice of the first meeting to consider this resolution be made and any other actions be taken as necessary to proceed with the process under Iowa Code Section 422D.1 to declare EMS to be an essential county service.

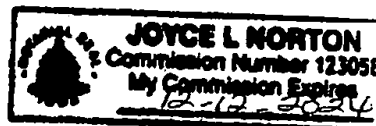

ORDINANCE NO.55

AN ORDINANCE to eliminate the residency requirement for Appanoose County Sheriff's Deputies and employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF APPANOOSE COUNTY, IOWA

SECTION 1 – PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to eliminate the state residency requirement for Appanoose County Sheriff's Deputies as required by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, Iowa Administrative Code 501 – 2.1(1).

SECTION 2 – RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT ELIMINATED. As of the effective date of this ordinance, Appanoose County Sheriff's Deputies and employees will no longer be required to be residents of the State of Iowa.

SECTION 3 – TIME AND DISTANCE REQUIREMENT. The Sheriff's Office shall assess the needs and demands of their office and shall establish a time and distance policy for the employees and their office.

SECTION 4 – EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.



RESOLUTION 2023-43**

WHEREAS: The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 Sub. (8), 321.255 and 321.471 to 321.473 to prohibit the operation of vehicles or impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highways or highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS: the County Engineer has completed (or has caused to be completed) the Structure Inventory and Appraisal of certain county bridges, in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards and has determined (or it has been determined) that they are inadequate for two-lane legal loads at allowable operating stress.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors that in addition to any previously established restrictions established by this Board, that vehicle and load limits be established, that signs be erected advising of the permissible maximum weights thereof on the bridges listed, that a violation of the ordinance is punishable by fine as set forth in Iowa Code section 321.471(2)(b), and that said limitations remain in place until the County Engineer certifies (or has caused to be certified) that said limitations have been resolved, as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-44

WHEREAS, a request has been made by the County Engineer to vacate a county road and bridge, the centerline of which is described as follows:

That portion of 510th Street (Old Primary Highway No. 2) with a Right-of-Way easement width of 66 feet sideline extended to intersect with the east Right-of-Way line of 135th Avenue, commencing approximately 750 feet north of the South Quarter Corner of Section 27, Township 69N, Range 19W at the intersection of said 510th Street and 135th Ave; thence southeasterly approximately 46 feet to the east Right-of-Way line of 135th Ave, said point being the point of beginning; thence approximately 1070 feet along the centerline of said 510th Street southeasterly to a point 60 feet west of the centerline of a residential driveway, together with all structures, including but not limited to bridge 992758 (FHWA #603380).

WHEREAS, on the 2nd of August, 2023 notice of said hearing was sent by certified mail to the affected property owners, all utility companies whose facilities are on the road right-of-way and the Iowa Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, on the 9th of August, 2023 a Notice of Public Hearing for the proposed road vacation was published in the Moravia Union and Appanoose Weekly, newspapers of general circulation in the County where said road is located; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held by the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors on the 21st of August, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors have determined that provisions of Chapter 306 of the Iowa Code have been met; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to in the best interest of the County and the affected property owners that the County not purchase the vacated road, but instead transfer said road to the adjoining property owners by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Appanoose County Engineer will remove bridge deck and abutments due to safety concerns of public
