NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERISORS OF APPANOOSE COUNTY that the speed limit be established and appropriate signs be erected on County Highway T30 at the locations described as follows:

From Iowa Highway 5 to the West City Limits of Exline - 55 mph

From the West City Limits of Exline to approximately 250 feet north of W 4th St. - 45 mph

From approximately 250 feet north of W 4th St through the city of Exline to approximately 850 feet south of Wall St - 35 mph

From approximately 850 feet south of Wall St to the South City Limits – 45 mph

From the South City Limits to the Missouri State Line – 55 mph
