

Appanoose County Secondary Road Department is accepting applications for a **Truck Driver and/or Laborer** to work out of the Appanoose County Secondary Roads Department at 1200 Hwy 2 West, Centerville IA 52544. The position to be filled will depend upon potential reassignment within the existing department employees.

The **Truck Driver** position is generally required to drive a semi-truck associated with delivery of aggregate materials and or equipment. Activities will include road maintenance activities utilizing hand and power tools, hydraulic equipment, driving of trucks and operation of construction equipment.

The Truck Driver reports to the Maintenance Superintendent or Crew Foreman, as assigned.

The **Laborer** assists with maintenance and construction activities as directed by the Road Maintenance Superintendent. Activities will include road maintenance activities utilizing hand and power tools, hydraulic equipment, driving of trucks and operation of construction equipment.

The Laborer reports to the Maintenance Superintendent or Crew Foreman, as assigned.

Both positions require having, or the ability to obtain within 90 days, a Class A CDL and live, or be willing to re-locate within three (3) months of employment to, within a 30-minute drive from home to the County Engineer's Office.
