NOTICE OF REGULAR PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of Appanoose County, State of Iowa, that the Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, the 4th day of June, 2024. The polls will be open from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM and held in the following places for the respective voting precincts.

Absentee voting will begin Wednesday, May 15, 2024. The final day to submit an absentee ballot request form to have a ballot mailed will be Monday, May 20, 2024 at 5 P.M. You may continue to vote absentee in the Auditor's Office until June 3, 2024 at 4 P.M. An absentee ballot request must be submitted before a ballot can be issued. Voter ID is required.

The Auditor's office will be open Saturday, June 1, 2024 from 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM for absentee voting.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who aren't pre-registered, such as, voters registering to vote on Election Day and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification or proof of residence, if required, may either have their identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, or cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by 6/10/2024 at noon. Public testing of voting machines will begin at the courthouse in the Auditor's Office on Wednesday, May 15, 2024 at 10:00 AM and will continue until all machines are tested.

The polling places are handicapped accessible. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. For further information, please contact Kelly Howard, Appanoose County Auditor, at 641-856-6191.

Below are the races and candidates that could be on the ballot. For the Primary election only by Iowa Code (43.42, 43.43) requires that all voters in a Primary election must declare a political party to participate in the Primary election. Depending on your district the races and candidates on the ballot will vary. State Senator District 12 and State Representative District 24 are for Johns, Independence, and Lincoln Townships and Plano Corporation. State Representative District 26 is the rest of Appanoose County.
