

Notice of Intent to Fill County Attorney Vacancy

Pursuant to Iowa Code, the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors intends to make an appointment to fill the vacancy in the office of Appanoose County Attorney on July 22nd, 2024, in the Board of Supervisors meeting room at the Appanoose County Courthouse in Centerville, Iowa. The person appointed will conduct the duties of that position until the seat appears on the General Election ballot in November 2024 or earlier if a Special Election is ordered. Persons interested in the appointment must submit a letter of interest and a resume no later than July 19, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. Applications must be sent to the Appanoose County Auditor's Office, 201 N. 12th, Centerville, Iowa. They can be mailed or hand-delivered.

Notice is further given that the electors of Appanoose County have the right to file a petition in accordance with Code of Iowa 69.14A requesting a Special Election. Said petition shall be filed with the County Auditor within 14 days after the vacancy is filled by appointment. The petition shall meet the requirements of Code of Iowa 331.306.
