Crews continue to ditch. The 100th Avenue pipe replacement was completed last week. The railroad flat cars are on site for the 580th Street bridge replacement. It's expected to be done in three to four weeks. The guardrails are up on the 150th and 110th bridges. The 150th bridge is now open to traffic. Seeding still needs to be completed.

The county treasurer shall withhold disbursement of township taxes until the statement is filed with the county auditor. The county auditor shall notify the county treasurer if taxes are to be withheld.
