APPANOOSE COUNTY RESOLUTION No. 2024-38

WHEREAS: The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Iowa Code Section 306.4 2023 Code of Iowa to operate and manage the Secondary Road System; and

WHEREAS: Appanoose County supports the efforts toward Zero Fatalities on Iowa's public roadways; and

WHEREAS: Appanoose County is committed to making the roadways under our jurisdiction as safe as possible with the resources provided the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That we, the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, do hereby with this pledge, formalize Appanoose County's support of the strategies outlines in Iowa's Five-Year Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) 2024-2028 and the overall vision of Zero Fatalities on Iowa's public roadways.
