

RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHING STOP REGULATIONS

Appanoose County Resolution No. 2025-6

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under the authority of the Code of Iowa Sections 321.255 and 321.345 to designate the location and erection of stop signs, and

WHEREAS, the County Board and County Engineer may designate certain roads as through roads with the erection of stop signs at specified locations furnishing access thereto or designation of any intersections as a stop intersection and erect like signs at one or more locations of access to such intersections, and

WHEREAS, the below-described road intersection is a safety concern to the public, as determined by the County Engineer, the County will adopt the following:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors, meeting in regular session, and upon recommendation of the Appanoose County Engineer that the County place and maintain a stop sign at the following locations

1. Stop southbound traffic on 150th Ave at the intersection with 150th Avenue and 465th Street in Section 01-69-19.
2. Stop southbound traffic on 183rd Ave at the intersection with 183rd Avenue and 520th Street in Section 33-69-18.

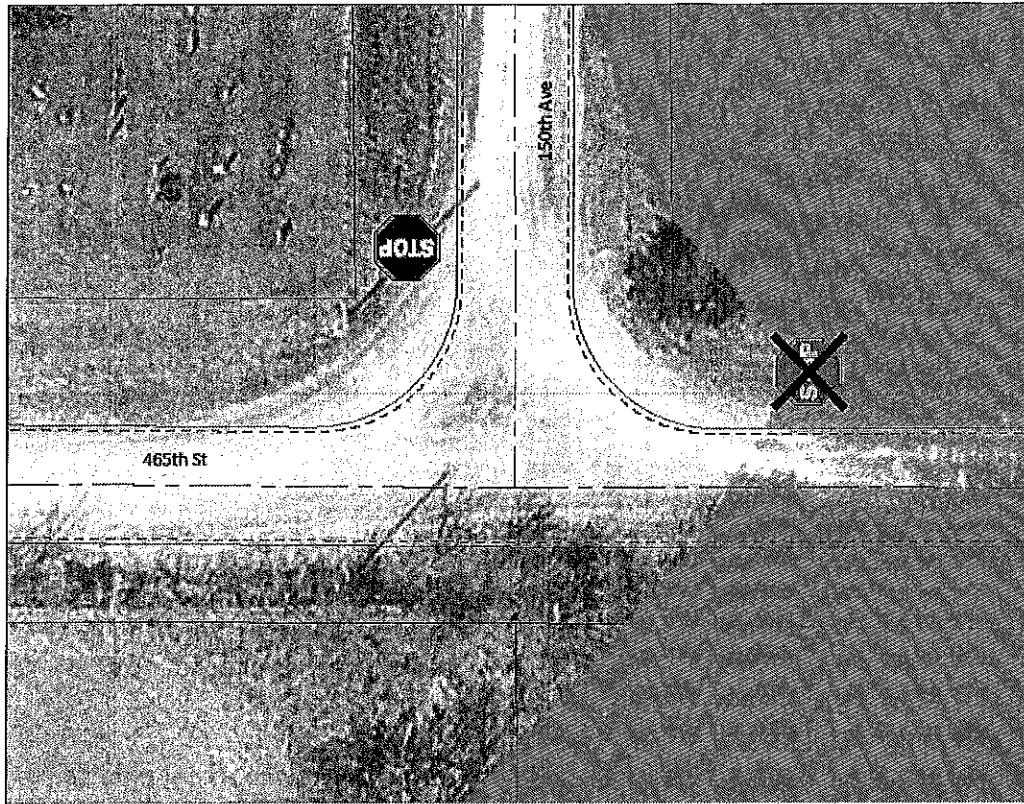

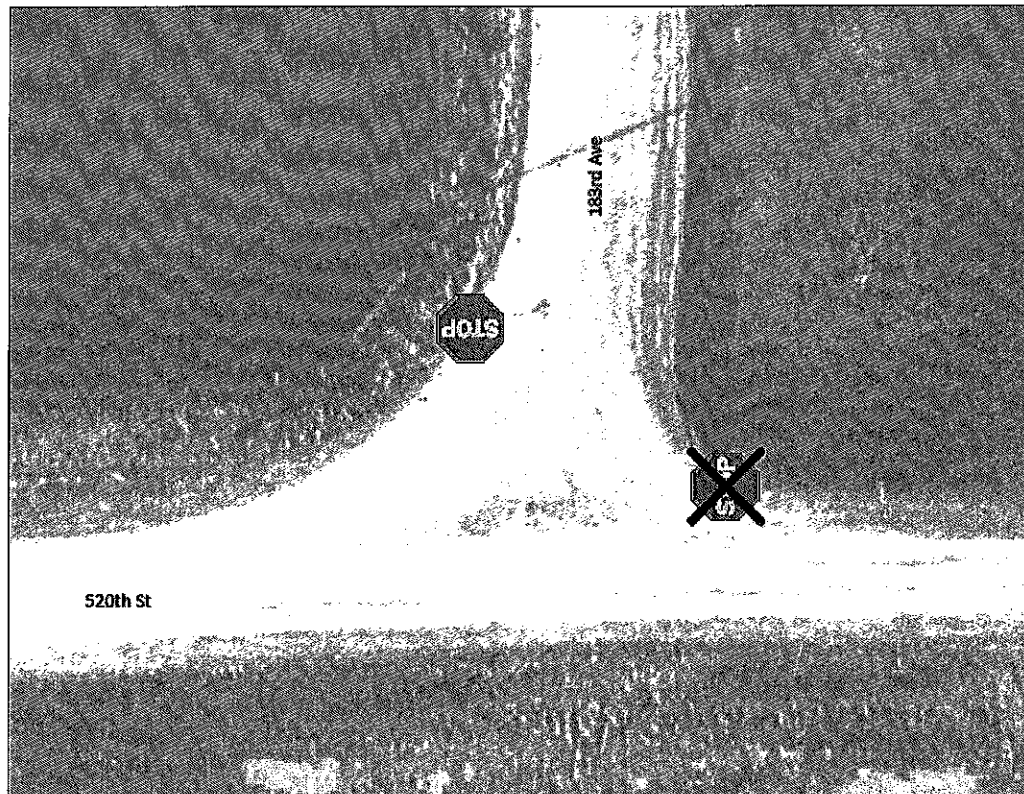
