

APPANOOSE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH  
SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM CLEANERS  
ORDINANCE NO. 4

1. "Appanoose County Board of Health Sewage Disposal/System Cleaners, Ordinance #4", duly published on the 5th day of June, 1986, is hereby amended in its entirety and the following shall be referred to as Appanoose County Ordinance #4 and known as "Appanoose County Board of Health Sewage Disposal System Cleaners".
2. That the amended Appanoose County Ordinance #4 shall be effective following passage by the Board of Supervisors and publication as specified in Section 331.302(7) of the 1991 Code of Iowa. At all times prior to the above described events, the former Ordinance #4 shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This rule is applicable to the owners of every vehicle used for the purpose of cleaning or disposing of waste removed from an on-site wastewater treatment and disposal systems in Appanoose County, Iowa. Annually, each vehicle shall be licensed with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and inspected by an authorized representative from the Appanoose County Board of Health for a fee of \$25.00.
  - a. Full Name
  - b. Address
  - c. Vehicle Make
  - d. Vehicle License
  - e. Tank Capacity, gallons
  - f. Dumping Site
  - g. License Application (Department of Natural Resources)
4. No vehicle used for the purpose of cleaning sewage disposal systems or disposing of waste removed from sewage disposal systems may be operated or used for said purpose in Appanoose County, Iowa without first obtaining a license from the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.
5. That this Ordinance adopts by reference Iowa Code Section 455A.6, 455B.171, and 455B.172(5) as they pertain to Commercial Septic Tank Cleaners. These standards are contained in 567 - Iowa Administrative Code - Chapter 68.
6. New or unregistered dumping sites will require a permeability test of the soil. A fee of \$50.00 will be required for the permeability test. A permeability rate of 2" per 60 minutes is required.

7. Sewage waste may be spread on farm ground, providing:
- a. Farm ground used to grow crops which may be eaten raw by humans, CANNOT be used for waste disposal.
  - b. The disposal site must be approved by an authorized representative of the Appanoose County Board of Health before dumping is permitted.
  - c. The disposal site must be a minimum of 300' from any dwelling, well, pond, or drainage ditch.
8. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance or any lawful order from the Appanoose County Board of Health or its appointed officers, shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed 30 days. Additionally, failure to comply with provisions of this ordinance will result in revocation of license.
9. If any section, clause, provision, or part or portion of any section, clause, or provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or application of any other section, clause, provision or part or portion of this ordinance.
