

ORDINANCE # 15

Acting pursuant to Section 321.285(5) of the 1993 Code of Iowa as amended the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors hereby determines that based on an engineering and traffic study the reasonable and proper speed limit on the roadway described as Landfill Road (beginning at County Road J46 thence South 1.4 miles to the existing Norris Price residence) shall be 40 miles per hour from May 1 to October 1 for the purposes of alleviating fugitive dust.

The Board of Supervisors directs that appropriate signs shall be erected on the roadway described above and such speed limit shall be effective at the time such signs are erected.

The foregoing Ordinance #15 is duly adopted and passed as follows:
