ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CEMETERY COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF APPANOOSE COUNTY, IOWA

- Section 1. A Cemetery Commission is herby established to assume jurisdiction and management of pioneer cemeteries in Appanoose County, Iowa pursuant to Section 331,326 of the Code of Iowa.
- Section 2. The Commission shall consist of five persons, residents of Appanoose County, Iowa appointed by the Board of Supervisors as follows: two of the members shall be appointed for a term expiring December 31, 2003, one for a term expiring December 31, 2004, and two for a term expiring December 31, 2005. Their successors in all cases shall be appointed for a term of three years and all appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- Section 3. The Commission shall select a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, and such other officers, as it shall deem necessary.
- **Section 4.** The Commission shall have authority to establish rules and regulations governing its organization and procedures, as it shall deem necessary.
- Section 5. The Commission shall have all the powers and duties relating to pioneer cemeteries, which may otherwise be exercised by Township Trustees under the Code of Iowa, except the Commission, shall not have the authority to certify a tax levy.
- Section 6. The Commission shall submit a proposed budget including the amount of available funds and proposed expenditures to the Appanoose County Auditor no later than December 15 of each calendar year.
- Section 7. The Commissioners shall receive no compensation for their services as such, but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.
- Section 8. Should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid, the remaining part shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.
- Section 9. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 10. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
