Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, Iowa:

SECTION I. <u>Purpose</u>. Code of Iowa Section 331.302, Subsection 9, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect and amends certain ordinances and/or repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Appanoose County, Iowa or to the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.
