An ordinance readopting the existing county code and repealing certain portions therein, Appanoose County, Iowa:

Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. Code of Iowa Section 331.302, Subsection 9, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect and amends certain ordinances and/or repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Appanoose County, Iowa or to the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.

SECTION 2. Readoption and Amendment of Current Code. The following ordinances have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the law provides.
