

APPANOOSE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 33

An ordinance readopting the existing county code and repealing certain portions therein,
Appanoose County, Iowa:

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. Code of Iowa Section 331.302, Subsection 9, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect and amends certain ordinances and/or repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Appanoose County, Iowa or to the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.
