Andy Meader from Liberty Communications provided an update on their completed broadband project. With a change in the location of the project the grant agreement needs to be reviewed prior to the final payment of \$375,000.

Nichole Moore from Chariton Valley Planning spoke to the board about updating the county's comprehensive plan which is due to expire in 2026. The board requested a proposal.

Hannah Wiltamuth and Austin Hoffman from the Conservation Department presented budget figures which would allow them to use 100% of their camping revenue to hire a full-time employee. Harvey motioned to use 100% of camping revenue for their staffing budget. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye.

Buban motioned to appoint William Knight to the Area XV Multi County Housing Agency Board of Commissioners. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.

Harvey motioned to approve the Eastern lowa Workforce Development Area CEO Shared Liability Agreement. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye.

County Assessor Mike Barth spoke about transferring coal rights back to the property owners. Harvey motioned to amend the Disposal of Coal Rights Parcels policy to \$100 from \$250. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye. Buban motioned to approve the Disposal of Coal Rights Parcels policy effective October 20, 2025. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.

Buban motioned to approve the 2026 County Weed Commissioner Certification Form and the 2025 Weed Commissioner Report. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.

County Engineer, Brad Skinner provided an update to the board. The J46 and S70 overlay project is for a November letting. The bridge on 130th is set to let in December. The beam and slab bridge project (which the pipes failed) is halfway done. Crews continue to work on ditching and pipe replacements, winter preparations and spot rock application.

Public Comments: Scott McCoy spoke about the disposal of coal rights and requested it be fair and equitable. Marty Ryan from Area XV Multi County Housing clarified Knight's term started January 1, 2025 and is a three-year term.

Harvey motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye. The Board adjourned to meet the call of the Auditor at 9:36 A.M.
