Harvey motioned to approve the liquor licenses pending dram for Pale Moon and Valley View Event Center. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye.

Brittany Hoover, NAMI South Central Iowa requested the courthouse be lit green in May for Mental Health Awareness Month.

Previously tabled pioneer cemetery request from Larry Wright was discussed. Kulmatycki spoke with Pioneer Cemetery Committee Chairman Tyler Morgan. The committee is in charge of 31 pioneer cemeteries in the county. They pay for them to be mowed three times a year. With an additional \$500 given annually, an additional two mowings could be performed. Harvey motioned to increase the annual allocation to the pioneer cemetery commission from \$1,000 to \$1,500. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye.

Buban motioned to approve the hiring of Gannon Swan as fulltime jailer effective 4/26/26 with a starting wage of \$25/hour. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.

Harvey motioned to approve the GIS Data Agreement with CoreLogic Spatial Solutions. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye.

Buban motioned to approve the hiring of part time seasonal Park Technicians Cassie Severson effective 4/6/26 at \$18/hour and Jackson Sisul effective 5/26 at \$15/hour. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.

Harvey motioned to approve the updated Appanoose County Employee Handbook (March 2026). Seconded by Buban. All vote aye.

There was discussion regarding the City of Rathbun's letter regarding dust control. County Engineer, Brad Skinner stated farm to market roads through towns are the county's responsibility. He recommended sitting down with the council and a boardmember to discuss it further. Kulmatycki stated they could do it on 4/27 at 9 A.M. in the boardroom.

County Engineer, Brad Skinner provided an update to the board. The asphalt project on J46 is running from the county line to Hwy 5 including the city of Numa.

Harvey motioned to open the public hearing for the FY27 County Budget at 9:10 A.M. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye. There were no public comments. Buban motioned to close the public hearing at 9:10 A.M. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye. Harvey motioned to approve Resolution 2026-12 FY27 County Budget. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye. Buban motioned to approve Resolution 2026-13. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.

The board recessed at 9:16 A.M. until noon.




The board reconvened at noon.

Harvey motioned to accept the current silent auction bids. Seconded by Buban. All voted aye


Buban motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Harvey. All voted aye.
